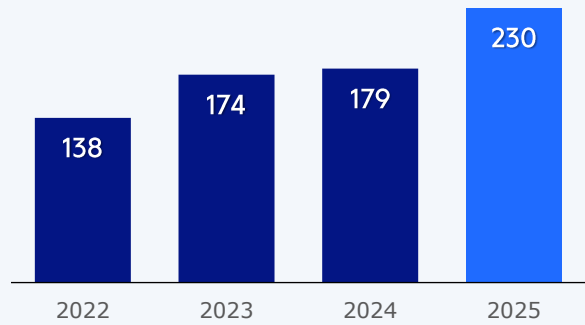

In millions USD

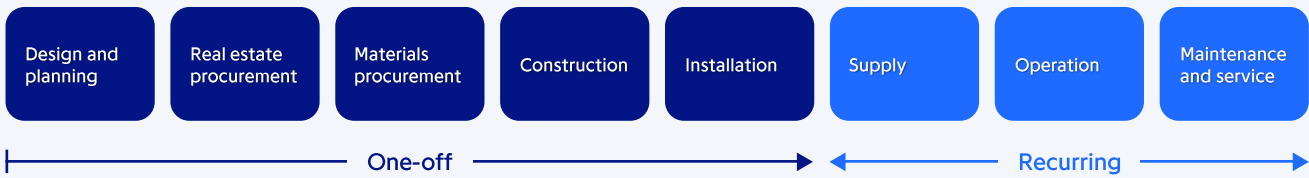

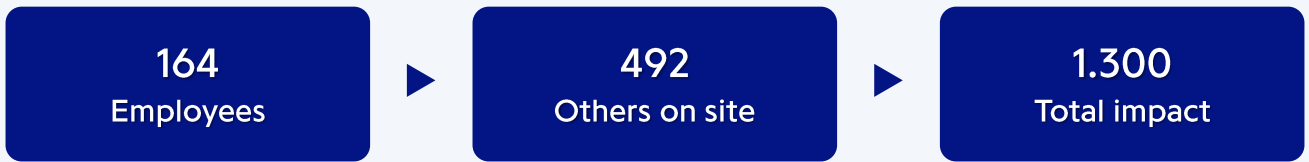
