



Danish consultancy and engineering industry in the current COVID-19-limbo?


The impact on the Danish economy



Gennemsnitlig nedgang i produktionen i udvalgt industribrancher i perioden marts-august sammenlignet med januar-februar





Private clients have significantly reduced new orders


Exports have come to a halt
